Young Authors' Writing Contest

Young Authors is a writing contest sponsored by the Charlotte Reading Association and the North Carolina Reading Association for students in grades K-12. An adult-entry category called Forever Young is also available. Student entries may receive local and state recognition.

2011-2012 Theme: “The Treasures of North Carolina”

Young Authors are encouraged to write in poetry or prose, as fiction or non-fiction. Students and Forever Young (Adult) writers might write about travel treasures, natural treasures, historical treasures, treasured memories, buried treasure, treasured people, treasured places... Let your students experiment – they will surprise you! Judging will be based on connection to the theme, overall writing quality, and creativity. Drawings may also be included. Students may receive adult help in editing grammar, punctuation, capitalization, and spelling. The content of the writing must be the student’s original work.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Each entry that is submitted must be sponsored by a membership in the Charlotte Reading Association. For example, if you have 4 individuals from your school who are members, then your school can submit up to 4 entries to the contest.
